Thank you for helping our P&C support both our school and the wider community. 😊

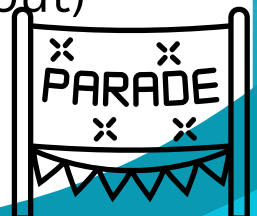
